## **GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT**

Please review the following guidelines with members of your party so that everyone has a safe and fun stay at our campground.

- Water park passes are sold separately. Water park includes access to floating obstacle course, swim deck, and watercraft (canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, and paddle boats).
- Camping fees are to be paid prior to setting up on the site.
- Check-in time for RV and tent sites is 2pm, check-out time is 11am. Check-in for cabins is 4pm, check-out time is 10am. If you wish to stay another day, or your departure is delayed, please check with the office to make sure no incoming campers have been assigned to the site, and to pay the late checkout fee.
- Every car in the campground must be registered and have a car pass affixed to it.
- Visitors are welcome but must register their vehicle at the office and obtain a parking pass and instructions on where to park. If your visitors plan on using our amenities a fee may apply. Please check with the front desk if you have further questions.
- Quiet hours are strictly enforced from 10pm to 8am; however please be courteous to your neighbors at all times.
- Running on generators is prohibited.
- Help us keep our campground green. Please do not park on grass or put mats or carpets on grass. No tents on full hookup or cabin sites.
- Fireworks and firearms prohibited.
- Campfires in designated pits only.
- Wildflower and domestic flower picking is prohibited. Please do not walk or climb in the flower beds.
- Washing vehicles or RVs is not permitted.
- Six people maximum on any site.
- Two tents maximum on any tent site, if space allows.
- You may pick up dead wood off the ground; however, driving nails into, cutting, chopping or bark peeling of trees or branches (whether the tree is alive or dead, as long as it is standing) is not allowed in any of our woods. Firewood is available at the store for a charge.

- Dumping of sewage, gray water, or garbage on the ground, in the lake, or in a fireplace ring is not permitted—a dump station is available at your site.
- Please place bagged trash in the large dumpsters located around the campground for your convenience.
- Pets are welcome, but state law requires a sixfoot leash. Pets are not allowed on the swim deck or in any building. You must clean up after them, and they should never be left unattended. Pets are welcome in designated, pet-friendly Cabins.
- Observe posted water park rules. Any child under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a guardian, age 18 or older. There is NO lifeguard; swim at your own risk.
- Report any accidents to the office immediately.
- Reservations from April 1 through Labor Day are non-refundable. If you need to cancel, you will receive a credit for a future stay. All fees and deposits for special events are nonrefundable.
- STATE LAW REQUIRES SEWER DONUTS!
- Golf carts, motorbikes, bicycles, and skateboards are to be operated between 8am and dusk only. Aimless buzzing of campsites will not be permitted. 5 mph speed limit is strictly enforced for ALL vehicles in the park. All golf cart drivers must have a valid license. This applies to all personal and rental golf carts, no exceptions.
- Rented kayaks, paddle boards, and paddle boats will need to be signed out before each use and when returned they will need to be signed back in with the safety coordinator. Children under 16 using kayaks, paddle boards, or paddle boats must be supervised by parents at all times. Life jackets are mandatory for all ages. Paddles and life jackets must be returned immediately after use.
